BYLAWS

- **Inter-Community Business License Amendment Bylaw No. 2233**—Council read the Bylaw a First, Second and Third time. The amendment was required to include the City of Merritt in the participating municipalities. View the [Report](#) / [Bylaw](#).
- **2020 Property Tax Exemption Bylaw No. 2251**—Council read the Bylaw a First, Second and Third time. This bylaw authorizes permissive exemptions from municipal taxes for certain lands following the *Community Charter Part 7, Division 7* eligibility criteria.
