REVELSTOKE VACCINATION RATE & COMMUNITY UPDATE

Currently, Revelstoke has the highest rate of vaccinations within Interior BC with 84% of residents over 12 years old with two doses. As of [October 30, 2021](#), the COVID-19 case count in the community is at 11 cases.
