CORPORATE SERVICES

WATER & SEWER REGULATIONS AMENDMENT BYLAWS

Council adopted Water Regulations Amendment [Bylaw No. 2341](#) and Sewer Regulations Amendment [Bylaw No. 2342](#) to ensure that related fees and charges are contained only in the City's Fees and Charges Bylaw.

ALTERNATIVE APPROVAL PROCESS (AAP) - WASTE WATER TREATMENT FACILITY & SCHOOL SAFETY LOAN AUTHORIZATIONS

Council directed staff to proceed with two separate [AAP processes](#) to allow electors to indicate whether they are against the City borrowing funds to facilitate construction of two capital projects - \$7,000,000 debenture over 25 years to facilitate the Wastewater Treatment Facility Upgrade Phase I and \$2,000,000 debenture over 15 years to facilitate the School Road Safety Project. The deadline for elector responses is September 20, 2022 by 4:30 pm.
