REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING

DEVELOPMENT SERVICES

1121 JOHNSON WAY REZONING

Council gave First and Second readings to Zoning Amendment [Bylaw No. 2345](#) and directed staff to hold a Public Hearing after the new Council is elected.

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KOA CAMPGROUND OWNERSHIP MODEL CHANGE

Council endorsed the conversion of a portion of the Revelstoke KOA Campground to a cooperative interest ownership model to allow the expansion of the shareholder base.

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DEVELOPMENT PERMIT DP2022-017 FOR 420 DOWNIE STREET - PROVINCIAL RENTAL HOUSING CORPORATION

Council approved DP2022-017 for Form and Character for the construction of a multi-unit mixed-use building and five row houses.

Council Adopted Wastewater Treatment Facility Upgrade Phase I Loan Authorization [Bylaw No. 2240](#). After a 30 day period the City will apply to the Inspector of Municipalities for a Certificate of Approval.

Council Adopted School Road Safety Project Loan Authorization [Bylaw No. 2334](#). After a 30 day period the City will apply to the Inspector of Municipalities for a Certificate of Approval.
